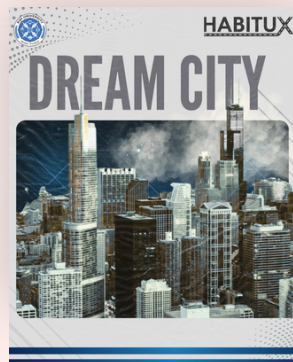

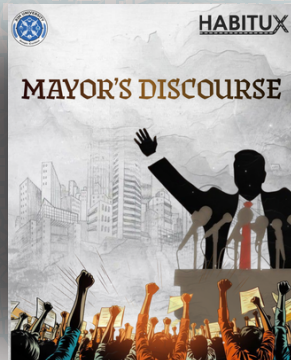
THE MAYOR'S DISCOURSE
